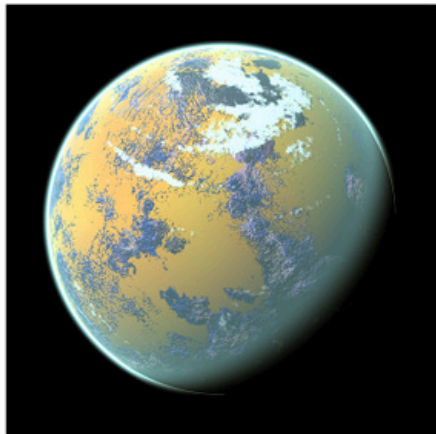

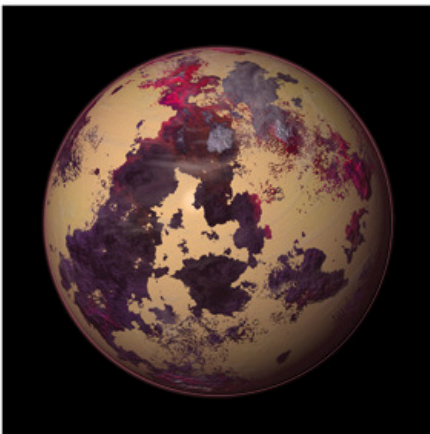
Planet: Kappa Kiera

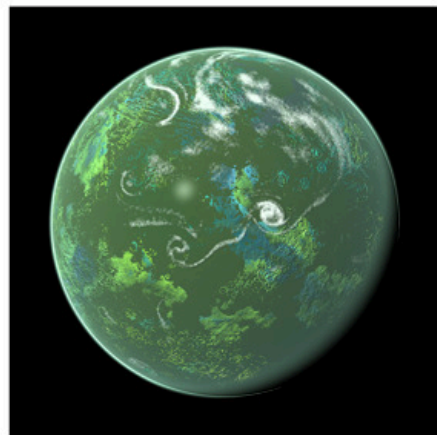

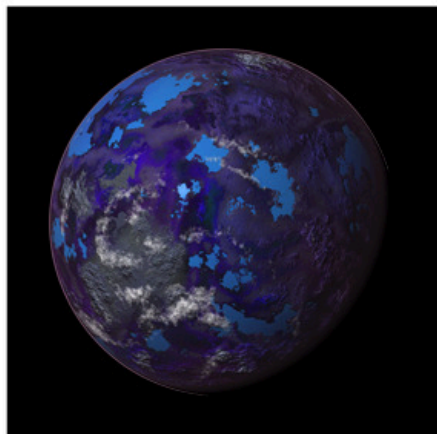
Planet: Epsilon Inara

Planet: Hytherlaria

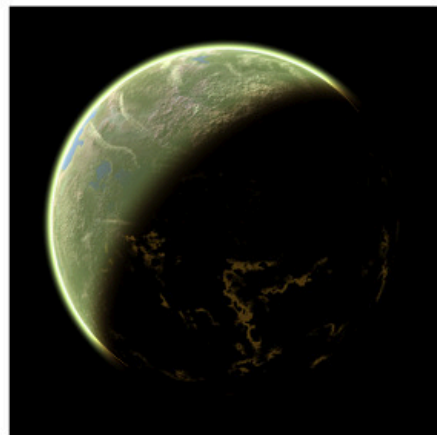


Initial Scans indicate this world does not have carbon-based life. There are some indications that silicon-based life may be present, but all current observations

Planet: Iota Eliora

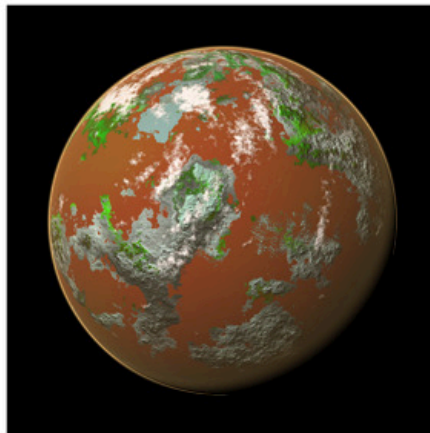


Initial Scans indicate this world is dominated by a fungal spore which infects all life forms which have developed here. It is unclear if this fungus effects alien life.

Planet: Gamma Dorinda

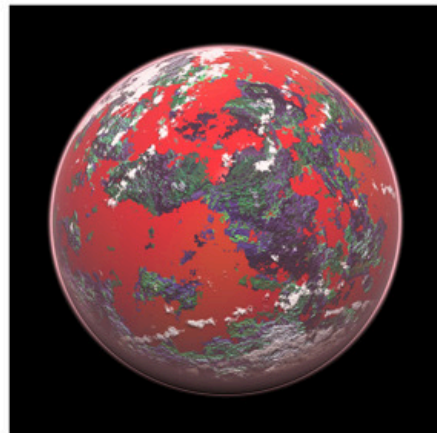


Initial Scans indicate this planet is toxic to most carbon-based life forms. However, an anomalous signal has been detected, suggesting some sort of technology exists.

Planet: Beta Argolis

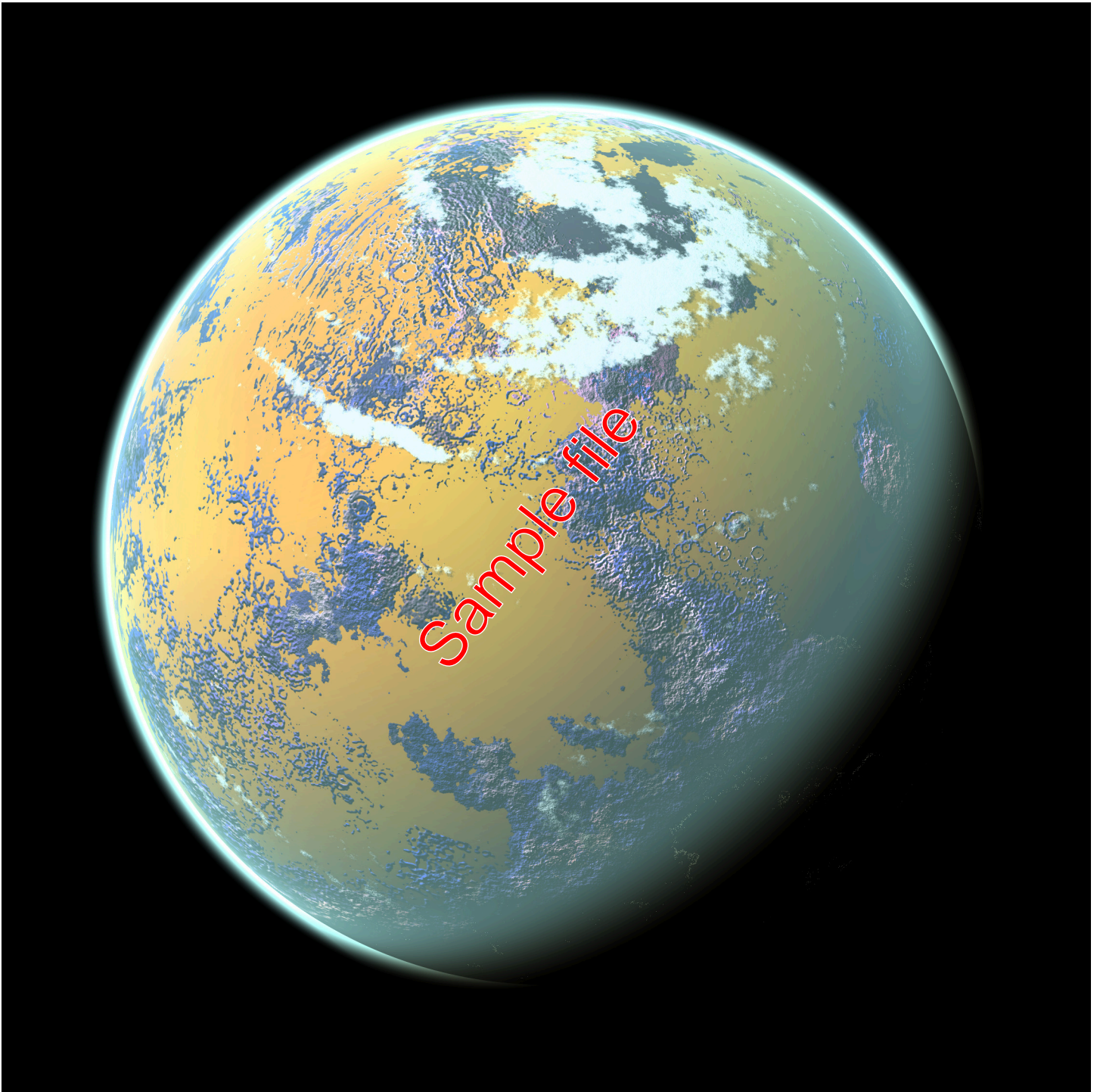


Initial Scans indicate this world has primitive life. The seas are dense with aquatic invertebrate animal life, and the land masses have some dense plant growth.
